All food, soft drinks, and meal ware will be furnished

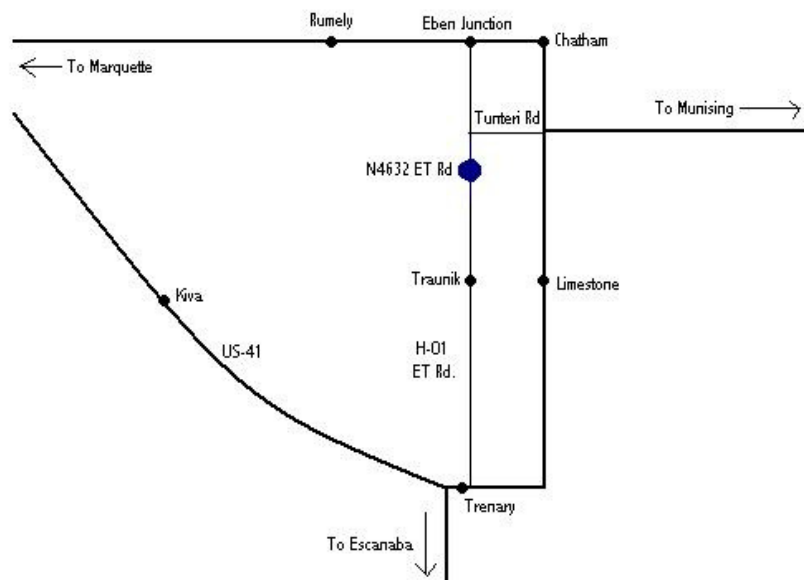
